POLICY

Branch 638 will cooperate with the Military Family Resource Centre (MFRC) in its program of providing Morale Mail Service for Overseas Troops by acting as a drop-off point for parcels being sent to Canadian troops serving abroad and liaising with the MFRC to arrange for the items onward transmission.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Ensure that the person dropping off a parcel for troops abroad completes the sign-in sheet (an example in Annex A).
- 2. Ensure that the sender completes the Canada Post manifest (example in Annex B)
- 3. Immediately inform the program coordinator at MFRC that the Branch has a package for pick-up (See Annex C for contact information).
