Sgt Peter Wartman UE was the second son of loyalist Abraham Wartman and younger brother of Adam Wartman who was killed by the rebel Pennsylvania Militia in 1777. All three served with Walter Butler's Company and their Mohawk allies at the Battle of Oriskany. Peter Wartman later served as a sergeant in Captain Herkimer's Company of Batteauxmen and during the war of 1812 was a lieutenant in the 1st Frontenac Battalion of the Sedentary Militia of Upper Canada.


